**FANATEC GT WORLD CHALLENGE EUROPE POWERED BY AWS ENDURANCE CUP
PRO-AM DRIVERS CLASSIFICATION**

The Sporting Board has received a request from SPS automotive performance driver Dominik Baumann, asking to be allowed to apply article 10.3 b) of the 2022 Sporting Regulations, and to thereby renounce the points he claimed during the TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa, in order to be on equal points with his full-season team-mate Valentin Pierburg in the Endurance Cup Pro-Am Drivers Classification.

Baumann's Bronze team-mates opted to race in the Bronze Cup during the 24-Hour race, and Baumann could not be entered in this category. As a Gold driver currently leading the Endurance Cup Pro-Am Drivers Classification, he will otherwise be removed from the classification in accordance with article 10.3 a)

In accordance with the spirit of the Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS, the Sporting Board accepts this as being a case of force majeure, and accepts the request.

The points renounced by Baumann will not be redistributed, and remain acquired by the team and manufacturer, and any other drivers competing in that car in the race in question.

The renounced points will be disregarded in reference to article 7.9e) of the 2022 Sporting Regulations


