The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Nos. / Drivers: 27 / Tyler Cooke and 111 / Vincent Abril

Competitors: Leipert Motorsport and JP Motorsport

Time (fact): 09:28 hrs

Session: Qualifying 2

Fact: Collision between cars 27 and 111 at Turn 14

Regulation:: Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: Cars 27 and 111 collided at turn 14, car 27 being on a fast lap while car 111 was on an out lap but pushing before starting a fast lap. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed CCTV evidence, both drivers agree that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. The Stewards concur with that view and therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
