Decision:

No further action

Reason:

Cars 77 and 10 collided at turn 15, both cars being on a fast lap. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed CCTV evidence, the Stewards note that car 77 slowed slightly due to a slower car in front. The Stewards determine that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision and therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
