The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Nos. / Drivers:** 22 / Stephane Denoual and 5 / Sam De Haan  
**Competitors:** CLRT and Optimum Motorsport  
**Time (fact):** 11:33 hrs  
**Session:** Qualifying 2  
**Fact:** Cars 22 and 5 collided at Turn 15  
**Regulation::** Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** **No further action**  
**Reason:** Cars 22 and 5 collided at turn 15. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed circuit CCTV evidence, the Stewards note that both drivers were on respective fast laps, that driver 22 says he had not seen car 5, and that driver 5 says he was much faster and thought car 22 was staying wide to allow him through. The Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
