
The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 33 / Jeff Kinglsey – Jacob Riegel – Romain Leroux
Competitor: Bullitt Racing
Time (fact): Not specified
Session: Qualifying 2
Fact: It was reported that mechanical work took place on car 33
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 41.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations
Decision: **No further action**

Reason: It was reported that mechanical work was undertaken on car 33. Having heard from the competitor's representative, who explains that the mechanics were simply inspecting accident damage (which could not be repaired) before parking the car for the remainder of the Qualifying session, the Stewards do not consider that there is clear evidence of a breach of the regulations in this instance and determine that no further action is appropriate in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
