The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 99 / Alex Aka  
**Competitor:** Tresor Attempto Racing  
**Time (fact):** 22:04 hrs  
**Session:** Race  
**Fact:** The driver created an unsafe situation by throwing a part of the car into the fast lane  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** **Fine of €250**  
**Reason:** The door of car 99 would not open when the car made a pit stop and in attempting to open the door the replacing driver pulled off the door handle which he then threw behind him such that it landed in the fast lane. Having heard from the competitor's representative and having viewed video evidence, the Stewards note that this was not a deliberate action and that the Car Controller quickly retrieved the handle. However, whilst noting the mitigation and that no competitive advantage was gained, the Stewards consider this to be a matter of safety and impose a fine of €250 in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
