Fact: a multiple car collision occurred shortly after the race start


Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Supplementary Regulations of the Fanatec World Challenge Europe 2023 Sporting Regulations

Decision: No further action

Reason: The Stewards received a report from the Race Director together with live TV feed and circuit camera footage. The Stewards heard from all drivers involved in this incident and their Team Managers. Further videos from on-board cameras were provided and were viewed. The Stewards consider this collision to be regrettable but find that none of the drivers was wholly or primarily responsible for its occurrence and reach the decision cited above.
