The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 25 / Patric Niederhauser
Competitor: Sainteloc Junior Team
Time (fact): 13:58 hrs
Session: Race 2
Fact: Alleged collision between cars 25 and 119 at turn 1
Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code
Decision: **No further action**
Reason: It was reported that car 25 made contact with the rear of car 119 at turn 1 on the first lap of the race. Having viewed live TV footage and on-board video from car 25, the Stewards can see that car 119 had instability under braking for turn 1 but do not consider that there is any evidence of contact having been made by car 25 prior to that. Accordingly, they determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
