The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 27 / Gregoire Demoustier
Competitor: Sainteloc Junior Team
Time (fact): 13:58 hrs
Session: Race 2
Fact: Collision between cars 27 and 91 at turn 2
Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code
Decision: **Reprimand and 1 Behaviour Warning Point to the driver**
Reason: Car 27 left the track at turn 2 and when rejoining made contact with car 91, causing car 91 to make contact with other cars. Having heard from the competitor's representative and having viewed on-board video from car 91, the Stewards consider that car 27 was predominantly responsible for causing the collision. They note that car 91 was unable to avoid contact due to car 71 alongside, though 27 may have expected 91 to move to the left. Noting that car 27 retired from the race as a consequence of this incident, the Stewards impose a Reprimand and 1 BWP in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
