The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 89 / Adalberto Baptista

Competitor: Akkodis ASP Team

Time (fact): 13:39 hrs

Session: Pre-Qualifying

Fact: Car 89 left the track and rejoined in an unsafe manner

Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2c) of Appendix L to the Code

Decision: **Reprimand and 1 Behaviour Warning Point**

Reason: Car 89 spun off the track and rejoined into the path of car 93, causing car 93 to leave the track in avoidance. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative and having viewed circuit CCTV footage, the Stewards note that car 89 stopped next to the barrier facing in the wrong direction. They also note that the driver waited for two cars to pass before turning onto the track to rejoin and that the driver's visibility at this point is limited. The Stewards determine that this is a breach of the above regulations but, noting the above mitigation, impose only a Reprimand and a BWP in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
