Countdown on the IN CAR MARSHALLING SYSTEM, that has priority on the flags

- At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
- At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr NO weaving (zig zag)
- In case of short FCY RESTART on short notice GREEN

OR

































SAFETY CAR

- SC on track during the FCY (NO lights) gets the leader. It will overtake cars if necessary.
- No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking
- "SC procedure"
- SC lights ON, all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap" "SC lights off" (all signalling removed)

"Green" – NO overtaking prior to pass the line





















PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC

Pit exit light remain **GREEN**

When the SC will pass the START LINE, the pit exit light will turn **RED**

When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn **GREEN** again



























RED FLAG PROCEDURE

Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking – drive to pit lane

Free practices: Clock will NOT stop

Qualifying: Clock will stop - lap time cancelled

Race: - Clock will stop - line up red line (start line) or follow the SC

- Order as when the red flag was declared

Parc-Fermé conditions - on the grid teams and officials ONLY

- Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later



























RED FLAG PROCEDURE

During the pit window:

- Cars back to the pit Parc-Fermé conditions
- pit stop permitted, when done or if already done before RF: parc-fermé
- Marshals will call the cars to line up in the order at the line of the last full lap before the opening of the pit window



























- At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.
- During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.
- During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.

TRACK LIMITS PENALTIES

- 1. FP: drivers will be warned and stopped, if necessary, lap times can be cancelled.
- 2. Qualifying: On the third time the best lap time of the driver will be cancelled.
- 3. Race: 1st time warning on the timing monitors,

2nd time warning flag.

3rd time final warning on the radio, at the

4th time the stewards can impose a 5 sec time penalty.
