Fact: Collision between cars 27 and 71 at Turn 7


Regulation:: Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: Cars 27 and 71 made side-to-side contact at turn 7, causing car 27 to leave the track. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV and on-board video evidence, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
