The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined photographic evidence and timekeeping data, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 159 / Benjamine Goethe  
**Competitor:** Garage 59 Group  
**Time (fact):** 09:50 hrs  
**Session:** Race 1  
**Fact:** Car 159 set its fastest sector 1 time up to that point whilst yellow flags were displayed in that sector  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 33.1b) of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2.5.5.b) of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix H  
**Decision:** **Drop of 3 grid positions for car 159 for Race 2 at this competition and 1 Behaviour Warning Point to the driver**  
**Reason:** Car 159 set its fastest sector 1 time up to that point (and the fastest overall sector 1 time) whilst yellow flags were displayed in that sector. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, the Stewards note that car 159 had not passed the location of the incident which caused the yellow flags before those flags were displayed. Therefore, in accordance with Article 33.1 of the Sporting Regulations, they determine that this is a breach of Article 2.5.5.b) of Appendix H to the Code and impose the penalty shown above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
