the IN CAR MARSHALLING SYSTEM has priority on the flags

























FUEL





Art 4.3 and 17 of the specific regulations to be strictly respected

- Max 2 drums of 60 L in each pit garage Fuel rig not included
- Total Max 240 L per pit garage

Earthing:...electrically earthed by means of an independent copper wire, ..., and which must not be combined with the air jack.



























LIGHTS





REPAIR AT NEXT PIT STOP

- One front headlight or one rear light or one stop/brake lights not functioning
- Number illumination not working or not visible
- One or both direction indicators not functioning
- Rain light functioning but not flashing
- Flashing indicators not working under FCY

MECHANICAL FLAG TO STOP

- Both front headlights or both rear lights or both stop/brake lights not functioning
- Rain light not functioning in wet conditions
- Repair at next pit stop








Speed 80 Km/Hr - NO weaving (Zig Zag)

FCY followed by SC except during the three 1st laps where it will directly SC

Countdown 20 seconds - marshalling system

- At 10 sec Yellow Flags & light panels No overtaking
- At O sec Boards and Yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr





































SAFETY CAR





- SC on track during the FCY (NO lights) gets the leader. It will overtake cars if necessary.
- No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking
- "SC procedure" SC lights ON, all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- Possible Wave-by
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap" "SC lights off" (all signalling removed)- "Green" NO racing, NO overtaking prior to pass the line

























PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC





- In case of "Wave-By" pit ENTRY will be closed until "WAVE-BY COMPLETED"
- Pit exit light remain **GREEN**
- When the SC will pass the START LINE (endurance), the pit exit light will turn RED
- When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn **GREEN** again

























ART 46.9 WAVE-BY PROCEDURE





- "SC LIGHTS ON" "PIT ENTRY CLOSED"
- "SC MOVE LEFT -ELIGIBLE CARS MOVE RIGHT"
- "START WAVE-BY"
- "WAVE-BY COMPLETED PIT LANE OPEN"
- "SC INTHIS LAP" "SC LIGHTS OFF" "GREEN"
- WAVE-BY PROCEDURE ENDS AT THE "GREEN"

Not < 30 min start or end of the race and 30 Min between GREEN and next FCY


















































SAFETY CAR RESTART LINE











PROCEDURE





Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking go to your pit box, the Clock will ONLY STOP during Qualifying

During the race:

- Stop at the red line Parc-Fermé conditions
- Restart behind SC
- 10' board Parc-Fermé OPEN
- 5' 3' 1' SC procedure Restart behind SC

TRACK LIMITS





FIA rule (contact with the white line) - NO tolerance

- Penalties are given to the Car
- The track limit infringements will be reset to zero after each period of 6Hrs
























TRACK LIMITS































TRACK LIMITS PENALTIES





- 1. FP & Night Qualifying: drivers will be warned and stopped, if necessary, lap times can be deleted.
- 2. Pré Q Q Superpole: every lap time deleted.
- 3. Race: 3 first time warning on the timing monitors,

4th time warning flag. (Screen only)

5th time final warning on the radio, At the

6th time the stewards can impose a 30" time penalty or a DT after 12 infringements. Messages on page 7

























TIME PENALTIES





- To be performed at the next pit stop
- Enter the pit lane pit box Parc-Fermé duration of the penalty
- Once the penalty time has elapse the team can proceed to the normal pit stop
- ! Investigations for TL may continue after the session / Race

























GRAVEL TRAPS RECOVERY PROCEDURE





After recovery cars will be dropped in one of the 3 specific zones to clean the gravel prior to re-join:

- 1. Zone 1 Sector 1 : Eau Rouge, right hand side at pit exit
- 2. Zone 2 Sector 2: Turn 9 motorcycle track
- 3. Zone 3 Sector 3: Turn 15 medical centre
