The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 35 - Maxime ROBIN

**Competitor:** Walkenhorst Motorsport

**Time:** 23:07

**Session:** Race

**Fact:** Car #35 exceeded driving stint

**Offence:** Alleged breach of Article 20.3 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS 2024 Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** No Further Action

**Reason:** After checking the data available, it was possible to verify that when car #35 was supposed to enter the pit lane, safety car has been deployed. Due to this, car #35 made a driving stint of 1:07:07.442 when the Extended Driving Stint is 66 minutes. The Stewards agreed that there was a case of force majeure and decided that no penalty was appropriate.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
