

RED LINE 50M BEFORE THE LINE






























PIT LANE

Minimum Drive Through Time: Pit lane = 378 m = 27"

























































































































Red lights remains ON Yellow flag @ all MP New Formation Lap Pole man - tempo

























FULL COURSE YELLOW



Speed 80 Km/Hr - NO weaving (Zig Zag)

FCY followed by SC except during the three 1st laps where it will directly SC

Countdown 20 seconds – marshalling system

- At 10 sec yellow flags & light panels No overtaking
- At O sec yellow flags + boards all cars at 80 Km/Hr
- Short FCY- "restart on short notice" "Green"

SAFETY CAR





- SC on track during the FCY (NO lights) gets the leader. It will overtake cars if necessary. No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking
- "SC procedure" SC lights ON, all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap" "SC lights off" (all signalling removed)
 "Green" NO overtaking prior to pass the line


























SAFETY CAR





























PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC



- Pit exit light remain GREEN
- When the SC will pass the START LINE (for standing start), the pit exit light will turn RED
- When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn
 GREEN again



























RED FLAG PROCEDURE



Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking - drive to pit lane

Free practices: Clock will NOT stop

Qualifying: Clock stops - lap time cancelled

Race: - Clock will NOT stop - line up red line (50m from the start line)

or follow the SC

- Order as when the red flag was declared

- Parc-Fermé conditions - on the grid teams and officials ONLY

- Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later





























- At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.
- During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.
- During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.

























TRACK LIMITS PENALTIES



CAMERAS EXIT Turn 4 and Exit Turn 17

1.FP: drivers will be warned and stopped, if necessary, lap times can be deleted.

2.Pré-qualifying & Qualifying: lap time deleted.

3. Race: 3 first time warning on the timing monitors,

4th time warning flag. (Screen only)

5th time final warning on the radio, At the

6th time <mark>30" time penalty at 12 Drive Through</mark>

TIME PENALTIES



- To be performed at the next pit stop
- Enter the pit lane pit box Parc-Fermé duration of the penalty
- Once the time has elapse the team can proceed to the normal pit stop
- Investigations may continue after the session / Race

























REMINDER



One change of line is permitted to protect the position

During Qualifying:

- All cars at racing speed in the last sector.
- Slowing down outside the racing line and not in the last sector.

























DRIVER CATEGORISATION - 2025



We would like to remind you of the following in terms of driver categorisation, for any drivers wishing to apply for a downgrade for 2025.

- Requests must be received on the <u>FIA Platform</u> by **August 31st** at the latest.
- Only requests on the platform will be examined. Drivers must provide both a letter of motivation for the request, and **data to support the request**.
- In terms of the data, this should be based on race times rather than qualifying laps or race results.
- The FIA meeting will be held at the end of September. After the meeting, drivers will be informed by email and on the FIA website of the result of their request, or of any upgrades which might have been decided. Once drivers are notified, please note that they have **7 days** to put in an appeal. It is important that they make sure the email on their FIA account is correct!
