Offence: Alleged Breach of Stewards Bulletin 6 and Article 43.1 of the GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS 2025 Sporting Regulations

Decision: No Further Action

Reason: Car #59 took part in Qualifying 2 - Group A and remained in the working lane during Qualifying 2 - Group B. After the session, car #59 was pushed inside the garage. Stewards' Bulletin 6 stated that it was allowed for cars taking part in Group to go inside the garages but it was not mandatory. Therefore, the Stewards agree that no breach of the regulations was committed and decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
